

So as you can see from this picture of Glen Disbrow's bike from a recent short ride those pesky "LOVE bugs kinda make a mess. Not just on the bike but also on your helmet and visor and/or goggles, glasses, etc. Whatever you may be wearing for eye protection. Hopefully you are keeping you mouth closed. Get my drift???

Well for us Floridians that do love to ride this is something we must put up with. Thankfully, it is only for a short few weeks. And of course, where can one go to get answers to clean them off our steeds?? Wait for it,...... the internet, of course, where else would one go?? Yes, there are all kinds of remedies on Facebook and other sites, naming all types of con-




