

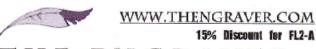
Claudia and I are looking forward to a great 2020 riding year (health willing) and having FUN with all of you. And it will start with Shrimp R Us!

How many times do we talk about drivers on the phone texting? I found this article in my AAA magazine and it hit home. Check this out:

Stop lights do not mean "Start Texting"

Everyone knows not to text while driving – but what if your car isn't moving? Although using your phone when you're sitting at a traffic light or stop sign might seem safe, it isn't.

Mental distractions – even using voice commands to change music or sending a text – can persist for as long as 27 seconds, according to research by the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety. The research compared different voice – activated systems. Even with the best systems, drivers remained impaired for more than 15 seconds after completing a task.

Texting While Driving Becomes a Primary Offense

As of July 1, 2019, Florida became the 45th state to make texting while driving a primary offense in Florida. This means officers can pull drivers over just for texting and driving, without any other traffic violation.

"Who Are You?" by Claudia Vega

Well we have come to the end of the year and the last issue of "Who Are You?" I was able to write 10 articles and it was fun writing them and getting to know all of our wonderful members.

This month for the final issue, we are going to get to know **Ray and Claudia Vega** a little better. They have been around for many years, but how well do you know them?

Ray's actual birth name is Rafael Vega Caraballo. His family called him Junior (and they still do today) because his father's name is Rafael Vega. Claudia's full name is Claudia Louise Zuccala (married name Vega), named after her Italian grandma Louise.

Ray and Claudia currently live in Boynton Beach and have lived in the same house for 42 years. Ray was born in Adjuntas Puerto Rico (a very small town up in the mountains) and Claudia was born in Glen Cove, New York – so yes technically Claudia is a New Yorker. But she moved to Florida when she was eleven because her father was a carpenter and he could get year round work down here. Ray's family moved to Boynton Beach when he was one. Other than a very short return to Puerto Rico, Ray has lived in Boynton Beach all of his life. Claudia's family moved to Lake Worth, where her paternal grandparents lived, then to Delray Beach – so she has been in the general area for many years. Ray and Claudia have been married 43 years this year and do not have any children, unless you count their 4 legged furry kids. Currently they have Bella, a 7 year old Chinese Shar Pei and they love her. She is also Ray's medical service dog. Ray and Claudia do have two nieces – Lindsey and Lacey - that they are very close too and have been involved in their whole lives.

Ray has had various jobs throughout his life, but for the last 20+ years he has worked for the Safety Council of Palm Beach County as a motorcycle instructor and then added high school driving instructor. He also taught other driver ed courses in English and Spanish. He loves his job. Claudia has only had 3 jobs, if you don't count Publix when in high school. She worked in the banking industry for nearly 17 years then moved on to office work for an electrical contractor for 17 years and finally worked for her brother in the towing industry for about 8 years. She didn't like moving around very much and enjoyed working in each of the industries that she worked in.

Ray and Claudia currently are the proud owners of a 2004 white trike. They started riding on a 1980 Honda CX 500 after being married for several years. Claudia had never been on a bike before, so this was a new experience. They had the bike for about a year before it was stolen from their carport, which ended up being the best thing that ever happened. With the insurance money they were able to buy their first Wing. They bought it at Boca Honda and Claudia tells the story that Ray went in with a "neon sign" across his chest saying "I will buy anything". There was a black wing on the floor and Ray was ready to buy it until Claudia said no. She did not like the color black, so the dealership pulled out a wine berry colored bike in the crate and that is what they bought in 1982. Over the years they have had several Gold Wings including a 1986 blue, 1990 black that was painted white after the first year, 2001 yellow and now a 2004 white that was converted to a trike in 2017.

Ray and Claudia joined GWRRA in September 1983, just 1 month after Bill and Cheryl. They were introduced to GWRRA by the father of their wedding best man. George Nicoll rode a GoldWing and invited them to a Chapter meeting. Ray and Claudia met Bill and Cheryl at that meeting – it was their first time too. Claudia found out at that meeting that there were several members that knew her father. It was a small town back then. When they left the meeting, Ray and Claudia were not sure if they wanted to join "this club". Claudia was afraid that too many members knew her Dad and they would not be able to get away with anything. But they did join GWRRA and Chapter A and as they say the rest is history.

Ray and Claudia like doing other stuff too. Ray is into Civil War history and they both like visiting battle sites and antebellum homes. Ray likes fishing and watching movies. Claudia likes photography, reading and doing crafts. They both enjoy traveling and seeing different things.


