

### MOTORIST AWARENESS IS EVERYWHERE

I know I keep saying this, but it is true! As you might know, May is Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. Here are a couple of quotes issued in a news release from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA):

"As the weather warms this spring, hundreds of thousands of motorcyclists will hit the streets, ready to shake off the winter blues and cruise. With thousands of deaths each year, motorcyclists are significantly over represented in traffic crashes and fatalities. In fact, per vehicle mile traveled, motorcyclists are about 27 times more likely than passenger vehicle occupants to die in a motor vehicle crash and 5 times more likely to be injured. It is essential that vehicle drivers pay complete attention on the roads: Even the smallest momentary lapse in a vehicle driver's awareness can result in the death of an unseen motorcyclist.

A key way we can reduce traffic fatalities and keep our roads safe is for drivers to understand motorcycle safety challenges such as size and visibility and riding practices like downshifting and weaving to be able to anticipate and respond to motorcyclists' behavior. Motorcycles are among the smallest and most vulnerable vehicles on the road, putting riders at greater risk of death and serious injury in a crash. In fact, research and state-level data consistently identifies a motorist as being at-fault in more than half of all multi-vehicle motorcycle involved collisions"

The NHTSA is not telling us anything new or that we don't already know. It is all well and good to quote all these stats, but what can we do to help prevent these accidents. The news release continues on listing some tips for motorists and tips for motorcyclists. To paraphrase here are the Tips for Motorists:

Motorcyclist still has the same rights of the road as any other motorist Always use a turn signal when changing lanes or merging with traffic Check all mirrors and blind spots for motorcycles before changing lanes Always allow more following distance when behind a motorcycle Never drive distracted or impaired

Now if we can just get motorists to heed these tips and basic rules of the road, it would make it safer for all.

As I stated there were also some tips for motorcyclists:

Wear a DOT – compliant helmet and other protective gear Obey all traffic laws and be properly licensed Use hand and turn signals at every lane change and turn Wear brightly colored clothes and reflective tape to increase visibility Ride in the middle of the lane where you will be more visible to drivers Never ride distracted or impaired

As you read this list of tips you will see it is nothing new – Ray has been preaching this information for years. Now, as a motorcyclist, we need to heed these tips and basic rules of the road. Remember it is not if you will be in an accident, but when.

PLEASE. PLEASE. PLEASE BE SAFE OUT THERE – WE WANT YOU TO COME HOME!

I truly hope you will participate in this FUN project and REMEMBER MOTORIST AWARENESS IS EVERY-WHERE!


