Hot, hot, hot, and I'm not talking about all those girls on one of those Elvis Presley movies. I'm talking about what the weather man is saying. It's going to be HOT! Holy Schmoly, it was 103 on my car temp gauge the other day. No wonder Chelsea wanted to ride in the air conditioned car! Smart service dog right there! Watching the news the other night the weather man said we gonna be having a heat wave for the next several weeks. Well I've been in Florida since 1957 and I know when the weather guy says several weeks hang on, we are in for it now! It's gonna be HOT!

Well, if you're not as smart as Chelsea and do have to ride your great steed please be sure to drink, drink, plenty of, wait for it...WATER!!! Best thing to stay hydrated is water! Even with some of those "sports drinks" we need to be careful and read the labels! Some of the ingredients of some of those sports drinks will not agree with some of the medications we may be taking, so be careful there. Check with your doctor. Whatever you do STAY HYDRATED! Remember if you stop perspiring, you are already dehydrated. Get off your bike, out of the heat and cooled down. Drink room temp water slowly to get hydrated. (A quick way I find to cool down is running tap water over my wrists and a wet rag around my neck will cool me down quickly. Just a tip.)

Also, if you are riding in this heat keeping covered with long sleeves will prevent the wind from drying you out too quickly, as well as the sun. When you perspire the wind through your clothing will actually help to keep you cooler. And as we Gold Wingers all know wearing our helmet is yes, warm but, we do not get that brain fry as one will without the helmet. If you remember an article in our Wing World magazine a few years ago that debunked that theory of whether it was cooler with or without a helmet and they proved it was cooler WITH a helmet. So, let's remember to ATGATT. Best protection for many reasons. Common sense being number one!

Okie Dokie, make sure you check you chapter calendar for what's going on and join in on the fun! I know you can't always make every activity posted but, try to make the ones you can. # Chapter Ride Coordinator and Educator Corner By Ray & Claudia Vega

As many of us get ready to head to Wing Ding 41 in Nashville TN we need to remember that we will be riding in different situations, including riding in a bigger city and what that type of traffic entails. I thought this article would be a good reminder regarding hidden traffic problems.

This information is from David L. Hough's "MCN Street Strategies A Survival Guide for Motorcyclists."

### **HIDDEN TURNERS**

### Having the Right of Way Doesn't Mean You Won't Get Hit

You're riding an arterial street, but traffic is light and you're aware that intersections, alleys and driveways are locations where accidents frequently occur, so you watch traffic ahead. When you spot vehicles on side streets that might pull out, you cover the brakes and prepare to make a quick stop if needed. You watch especially for oncoming cars that might turn left across your path because you know that left-turners are a major hazard for motorcyclists.

As you approach an intersection, you are watching for such left-turners. There's a large truck to your left waiting to turn left, but as you begin to pass the truck you can see that there are no cars in the opposing lane that could turn left, so you accelerate back to speed to get through the intersection quickly.

Just as you pass the truck, a car suddenly shoots out from the left in front of the truck and directly into your path. You roll off the throttle and swerve hard to avoid a collision. Fortunately, you miss the car, but the rear end slides out and the bike crashes on its side, skidding into the curb in a trail of sparks and broken plastic. The driver speeds away, leaving you to pick yourself up and survey the damage.

It is wise to understand that intersections are dangerous locations, and it is smart to look for left-turners. But you must predict that a left-turner could be hidden behind a large object such as a truck. Accelerating into an intersection increases forward energy, which increases your stopping distance.

You should always be prepared to stop within your sight distance, which in this case was severely limited by the truck. Even though you may have the legal right – of – way, you should slow down before proceeding until you can see around the object.

Let's discuss this at the next Chapter gathering – bring me your questions and stories when you were in this situation. In the mean time let's ride and have some FUN!





### MOTORIST AWARENESS IS EVERYWHERE

Last month I found some information in my AAA Living Magazine that I thought was interesting and went along with Motorist Awareness. Well I found another article in the magazine that is pertinent to Motorist Awareness. Please read it and let me know what you think.

With the heat ramping up this summer so are people's tempers on the road. This article has some good advice for you.

This article is courtesy of AAA Living Magazine May / June Issue:

### **CROSSING THE LINE**

Unchecked emotions can lead to aggressive driving and even road rage. Here's how to identify these dangerous habits – and how to prevent them.

### Aggressive Driving:

Speeding, weaving, tailgating
Changing lanes without signaling
Cutting in front of someone and then slowing down
Running a red light
Blocking cars attempting to pass or change lanes

### Road Rage

Cursing and making rude or obscene gestures Throwing objects Ramming or sideswiping another vehicle Forcing a driver off the road

More than three-fourths of U.S. drivers admitted to aggressive driving behavior in the past year:

51% Purposely tailgated. 45% Honked to show annoyance / anger. 33% Made angry gestures. 12% Purposely cut off another vehicle. 4% Got out of the vehicle to confront another driver and 3% Purposely bumped or rammed another vehicle.

### **Safety Tips:**

For us on motorcycles, we have seminars and riding courses to help us improve.

### Don't offend:

Don't intentionally force another driver to brake or turn in response to something you have done.

This advice is not only for when you are driving your car – it is also good for when you are riding your bike.

### Be tolerant and forgiving:

Don't take it personally if the driver of a vehicle is tailgating or cuts you off. The other driver may just be having a bad day.

This is good advice whether you are driving your car or riding your bike – but also remembers drivers don't see motorcycles so just get out of the way – they are bigger than us.

### Do not respond:

Avoid eye contact, don't make gestures, maintain space around your vehicle and call 911 if you believe you are in danger.

Again just get out of their way – they are bigger than you. Who do you think will win in a battle between a car and a motorcycle?
