While I was reading this chapter in David's book all I could think about was I95 and South Florida! Read it and tell me if it isn't talking to you and every time we travel on I95.

#### LANE CRASHING

Before You Change Lanes, Take A Good Look Around.

You're cruising down the freeway in Sunday afternoon traffic, heading for home. With an interchange coming up where you know there will be traffic exiting and merging on the right, you stay in the left lane. But there's a pickup truck ahead of you, cruising in the passing lane. You flash your high beam as a signal that you want to pass, but the driver doesn't seem to notice, so you decide to pass the pickup on the right. You quickly check your mirrors, and flick on the right turn signal as you swing over. Suddenly you realize a car in the right lane is also dodging into the same space. Barely able to swerve, you brake to avoid a collision. It's a close call, and your blood boils at the inconsiderate actions of your fellow motorists.


Yes, it's inconsiderate to cruise in the passing lane or to change lanes without signaling. But remember, the purpose of turn signals is to let other drivers know what you're going to do, not what you're already doing. If you start signaling when you first decide to change lanes, perhaps other drivers will realize your intentions.

It's also up to you to keep from getting run over. When changing lanes, you should always look for traffic in adjacent lanes, and position yourself so that you aren't parallel to other vehicles. Watch especially for cars on the other side of a lane you intend to move into. For example, if you observe a car moving up in the right lane you should predict the driver will be changing lanes, too, even if he or she doesn't signal.

#### MOTORIST AWARENESS IS EVERYWHERE

I found an article called **Safe Driving – Putting Ideas Into Practice** – that I thought was interesting and wanted to share with you.

The AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety research shows that drivers' attitudes about safety need to become actions.

The new year is time when we're often inspired to change our behavior. We set goals to get in shape, save money, find a better job – or even drive more safely. But the first step is to identify an area that needs improvement. In looking at results from the 2013 Traffic Safety Culture Index, drivers may want to resolve that they will walk the walk and not just talk the talk when it comes to driving safely.

Since 2008, the AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety has conducted an annual national survey of Americans ages 16 and older about their driving behaviors and attitudes. The goal? The Foundation seeks to foster a social climate in which safety for all road users is highly valued and rigorously pursued. As in previous years, the 2013 data indicates a climate in which people understand – and voice – the dangers associated with risky driving behaviors, but don't heed that knowledge much of the time. It's a prevailing attitude that the Foundation characterizes as "Do as I say, not as I do".

For instance, on the topic of drowsy driving, almost 95 percent of drivers believe that it is at least somewhat unacceptable to drive when you're so drowsy that you have trouble keeping your eyes open. But almost 30 percent of drivers also admit to driving under these conditions within the past 30 days. You can find the same attitude in the index's responses about distracted driving. While nearly 89 percent of drivers say that talking on a cell phone while driving is at least somewhat of a concern, close to 70 percent admit to talking on a cell phone while driving within the last 30 days.

So, it becomes clear when looking at these results that many drivers perform the same activities that they recognize as being dangerous. Many lives and dollars could be saved on our roads if motorist put into action their beliefs and values about safe driving.

The AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety funds research projects and develops resources for all road users.
