## ***Chapter Ride Coordinator and Educator Corner*** **By Ray & Claudia Vega**

I know it has been hard just sitting home while we watch our beautiful spring weather pass us by.

I read an article in Chapter FL2-H's newsletter with suggestions on what we can do to pass this time. I thought it was good and maybe a little funny too. Here are the suggestions:

Read your bike's owner's manual. This I thought was funny – how many of you have even looked at your owner's manual or even know where it is?

Change your bike's oil and filter. If you know how to do it, this is a good idea and a way to get ready for when you do get back on the bike and ride.

Do a TCLOCS inspection on your bike. Another good idea to get ready to ride.

Clean and wax your bike. Love bug season is upon us and the wax will help the bugs not to stick so much and makes it easier to wash them off.

Clean the foam interior lining and exterior of your helmet. Cleaning the interior lining may freshen it up a bit and a little wax on the helmet (not the shield) may help keep the love bugs off.

Inspect the first aid kit in your bike. This is a great time to make sure it is complete and get rid of and replace all the out dated items.

Review and update your emergency medical and contact information sheet in your bike. This is very important, especial if you are involved in an accident. The standard is to keep this information in the left hand pocket of the bike in a water proof zip lock bag or container. I also keep it in my wallet and in the trunk of the bike too.

By completing these tasks at least you will feel like you are getting ready for the riding season.

If you have been keeping up with your emails, you have received notices through Group Works and from Bill and Cheryl regarding **online GWRRA seminar training**. Classes are offered throughout the week at 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm CENTRAL time – that's 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm for us. It is easy to sign up for these classes – simply go to gwrradot.com, look at the middle of the page and you will see a green stripe running across the page – click on that and it will take you to the sign up page. Complete the information requested and when it comes to choosing an online class use the drop down arrow and find the class you want and click on it. Then submit it. You will be notified by email with instructions.

I would like to recommend a couple of classes that would be a good refresher for all of us during this break. Here are the ones that I plan on taking:

**TEAM RIDING** – Thursday May 14 or Friday May 22 – times are 4:00 pm or 7:00 pm

**RIDING IN THE RAIN** – Monday May 18 – times 4:00 pm or 7:00 pm

**RIDING IN THE HEAT** – Wednesday May 20 – times 4:00 pm or 7:00 pm

I may throw in there **MATURE RIDER** on Wednesday May 13 or Thursday May 21 – I have never taken this course.

Claudia wants to take **A VIEW FROM THE REAR** – this sounds interesting and is being offered Thursday May 7 at 4:00 pm (the 7:00 pm class is full) or Tuesday May 12 at 4:00 pm or 7:00 pm.

If you are interested in attending any of these online classes, give us a shout and maybe we can line up the times and take them together. The classes are limited to 20 participants and you will need a computer or tablet since it is a visual class.

In the mean time – keep safe and healthy and we will see you soon.

### Coronavirus and Motorcycling

I would be remiss if I didn't talk about the Coronavirus as it relates to motorcycling. Disclaimer: I am not a doctor and I DID NOT stay at a Holiday Inn Express. (That's a joke if you don't get the reference.) So, how do we deal with the Coronavirus threat as it pertains to us, "The Motorcyclists"?

Let's start with what should be our safety premise anyway when we are permitted to ride. **ATGATT - All The Gear All The Time.** Let's look at how wearing the appropriate safety gear can help prevent the spread of a virus. Start with the **helmet**: Leave your face shield down while talking to other people. It kind of makes it hard to hug or kiss someone with your helmet still on. If you sneeze, although messy, at least you are keeping your germs to yourself. It's also hard to accidentally touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your face shield is down. Your **gloves**: Leave your gloves on when you get off your bike at the gas station. Try getting your money or credit card out and back into your wallet with your gloves still on. Wipe off your credit card with disinfectant after each use. Punch any key pads with your glove covered finger and operate the pump handle with your gloves still on. If you accidentally go to shake someone's hand your glove will serve as a barrier. Keep your **jacket** on just in case you accidentally lean up against something you should not have. I hope I don't have to mention exposed legs as well.

Some additional safety precautions being told to us are by governmental officials are: **Avoid Crowded Places. Do Not Use Public Transportation. Stay in Well Ventilated Places.** Keep A **Safe Distance Between You and Others.** And finally: **Maintain A Positive Attitude.** Well, I don't know about you but I think I can accomplish all of those restrictions by "**Riding My Motorcycle**".

We have been riding our motorcycle, when it is permitted, during this pandemic. We have noticed an increase in bicyclists, boaters, and other motorcyclists. These are all good ways to get out of the house yet stay spread apart from others.

Be careful around small family member children. The common reaction when greeting them would be to hug and kiss them. Remember small children are more likely to be carriers of the Coronavirus without catching it themselves or showing any symptoms.

Just a quick training note: Before the Coronavirus Restrictions arrived, we were working on a much needed Rider Training Site for GWRRA members in the Tampa area. The restrictions came and any possible Riding Sites we were considering were put on hold. It is unknown when the availability of these sites will become open or when the country gets back on track. As soon as we know anything about a Riding Site, we will let you know. Many of us are in need of Riding Courses. You are **NOT** being penalized if anything in your Levels Program requirements have expired after January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020. You have a grace period until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 to take any necessary courses to become current.

# ***MOTORIST AWARENESS IS EVERYWHERE***

May is Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month. With warmer weather, it's time to remind everyone to be on the alert and to share the road with motorcyclists.

Riders, who have been cooped up all winter or in our case cooped up due to the virus, are excited to be out on the road again, but that shouldn't stop them from using caution.

We have to remember that Motorcycle Safety is a Two-way Street

Both motorcyclists and motorists need to be aware of their surroundings. Checking blind spots, mirrors and using turn signals are necessary when changing lanes and when passing.

Distracted driving has been on the rise, too. Distractions during driving could mean the difference between seeing a motorcyclist or not when preparing to change lanes. Don't let one text change anyone's life forever!

Riders need to take precautions as well. Take a defensive driving course, wear protective gear and keep your bike in its best working condition. Also, be aware of any road hazards and dangerous weather conditions.

We know when spring is in the air, that motorcycles are everywhere. We know you long for the freedom that comes with riding on the open road. That is why it's critical to respect your machine and improve your skills throughout your lifetime.

But let's face it that is only half the story. Motorists interested only in four wheeled vehicles still have a major responsibility in keeping motorcyclists safe on the road.

In recognition of National Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month, the National Safety Council reminds riders and drivers to do their part.

Here are some stats:

In 2017, 5172 motorcycle riders and passengers died in crashes. Fatalities among motorcycle riders and passengers have more than doubled in number since 1997.

Motorcycles make up 3% of all registered vehicles and only .6% of all vehicles miles traveled in the U.S.

Motorcyclists account for 14% of all traffic fatalities in 2017

28% of riders who died in a motorcycle crash in 2017 were alcohol impaired

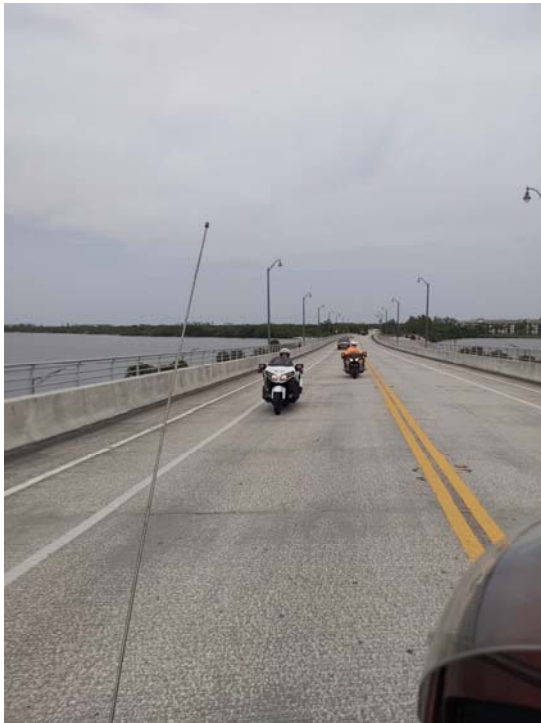
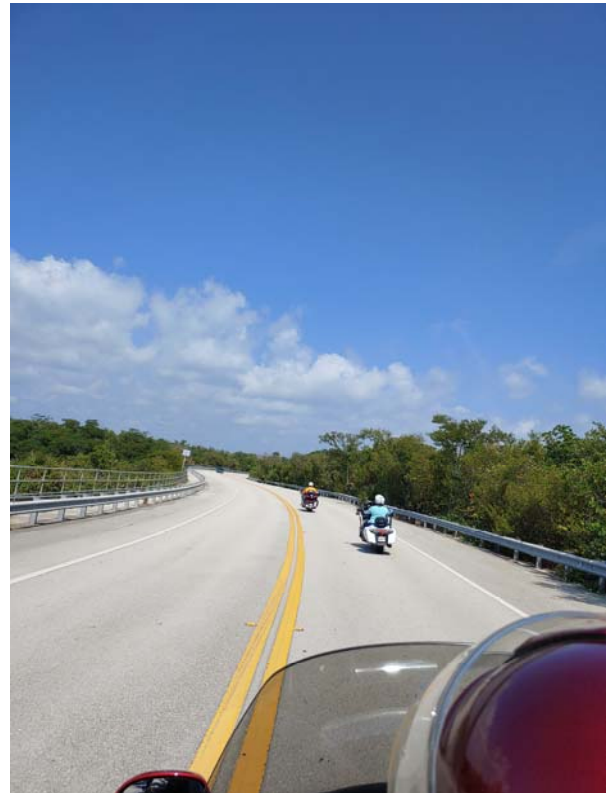
91% of riders who died in motorcycle crash in 2017 were male.

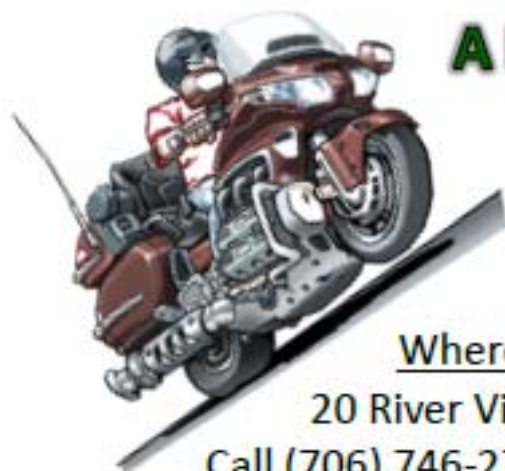
