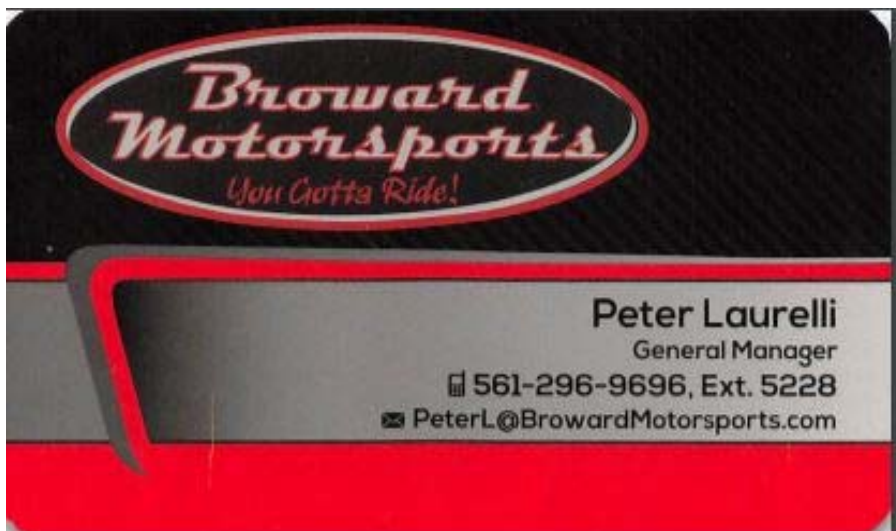

CLASSES

MFA CLASSES

Some of you may have heard that the home office has authorized MFA Classes to resume. They are leaving it up to the individual Districts to decide whether or not it is safe to continue classes. However, our great State of Florida is still significantly impacted. We will not be continuing MFA Classes at this time. We will closely monitor the situation and open classes back up when it is prudent to do so. Please do not worry about your Levels expiring. This is being addressed. The amount of down time due to the pandemic shut down is being added to extend your expiration date. Our health is the priority now. Be Safe! Be Healthy!

RIDING CLASSES

We have had a few questions about Riding Classes including the TRC and ARC. Yes, they may resume, however in some area's masks, non-contact forehead thermometer checks, and social distancing are required. Local and State guidelines must be met. We actually just did two courses in the Tampa area in Largo so that those who's Levels were expired could once again become current. It was a good time but we were a little disappointed that the classes were not full when we had gotten so many asking when classes would be offered. A BRC-2 is an approved GWRRA ARC equivalent, MSF 2-Wheel Course and the STEP Trike Evergreen Course is used in place of a GWRRA TRC. The Evergreen STEP Course allows Sidecar Rigs to participate in the same class thus eliminating the need for a separate class. Both of these classes are an excellent opportunity for members to fine tune their riding skills and maintain their Levels Program. We don't anticipate scheduling any riding courses until the weather cools down, as the heat index this summer has been unbearable.

The ability to conduct Riding Classes has not really been hindered by the pandemic. Our hot Florida weather this time of year is more of the deciding factor. I have been conducting 1 or 2 MSF Riding Classes for licensing per week throughout these troubled times. State medical guidelines are being followed. It has been hot out on the riding pad. During a recent class the outside temperature was 95 degrees with a feels-like temperature of 106. A portion of the asphalt on the pad had melted and the bottom of my boots stuck to the pavement. Now that's hot! We can resume classes when the weather cools down. Chapter Directors know their members and know when it would be appropriate for them to schedule a riding class. We are in the process of acquiring new locations to conduct Riding Classes. At present we are looking at locations in Largo, Ocala, Eustis, Orlando, and Melbourne. As you can see these locations are all in and around the middle of the State. If you have access to and have used other locations further North or South, continue to use them. Please advise us if you set up a class so it can be properly advertised and documented.

Chapter Ride Coordinator and Educator Corner

As you know, it is **HOT!** We have to take hydration seriously. It is so hot, that everyone needs to keep up with hydration whether you are on a bike, in a car or just being outside. As I suggested before, you need to figure out a way to carry water on your bike. A small soft sided 6 pack cooler loaded with a few frozen bottles of water would do the trick. Let's make this a safe summer while having FUN!

Normally I would also be talking to you about watching traffic as schools start to open up and there are more busses on the road and more traffic as parent take their kids to school. I find that parents are in a hurry so it is important to keep your eyes open around school areas. This year we do not know what August will look like or what it will bring. But whatever it is, we need to be prepared.

The below article is to remind you what to look for on the road whether you are on your bike or in your car.

The following information is from David L. Hough's "MCN Street Strategies A Survival Guide for Motorcyclists."

ROLLING STOPS

Clever Riders Always Plan On a Complete Stop at Stop Signs

You are approaching a busy intersection from a side street. Your street has a Stop sign. Immediately, you observe a gap in the oncoming traffic where you can make your right turn – if you don't waste any time. You quickly slow almost to a stop and then immediately make your turn into traffic. But, just as you begin to turn, a car changes lanes into your path. You aren't moving fast enough to swerve out of the way and you aren't prepared to do a quick stop, especially while leaned over. The bike ricochets off the front fender of the car and the accident is *your fault*.

Rushing into intersections isn't wise. If you're not prepared for a stop when you realize your path is blocked, it's difficult to keep the bike under control. Even a brief stop would give you time to evaluate the situation and observe a car moving into your intended lane. Remember that more motorcyclists are injured and killed at intersections than at any other location.

The best way to be prepared for surprises in situations such as this is to come to a complete stop at **all** Stop signs, with your left foot supporting the motorcycle and your right foot on the brake pedal. Keeping your foot on the rear brake not only keeps the bike from creeping ahead but also illuminates the brake light to signal traffic behind you.

Is It Worth It?

It's the same bar of iron used differently, and the value changes depending on how it was used.

Our Membership is that bar of iron. We all pay the same amount to be a Member. However, what we do with it is up to each of us. The value is also up to us. So how can you add value to your Membership? Here are a few things you can do to add value:

- Attend Monthly Chapter gatherings - get involved;
- Attend seminars - what a great way to learn about GWRRA;
- Get involved in the Rider Education Levels Program - just might save your life;
- Visit other Chapters in your area - there are amazing Wingers to meet;
- Attend your District Rally and Wing Ding - you will have an awesome experience and again the people you will meet are amazing;
- Take on a position - you'll always get more out of your Chapter, District by giving back;
- Your monthly copy of Wing World;
- Rescue Plus;
- And last Participate, Participate, and Participate!

These are just a few ways you could add value to your Membership. In fact, you may have some ideas of your own that were not listed. The point is we want you to see the real worth of your Membership and that the more YOU get involved, the more your Membership has real value and worth. 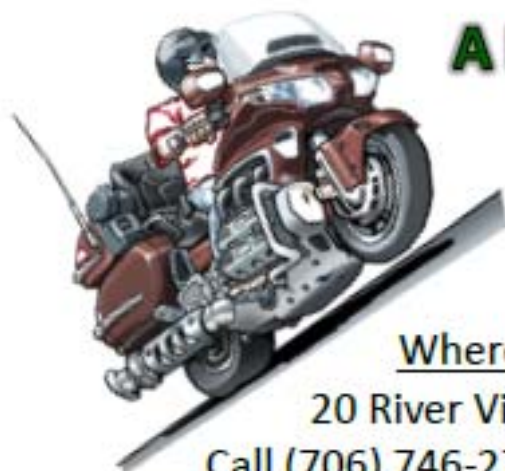

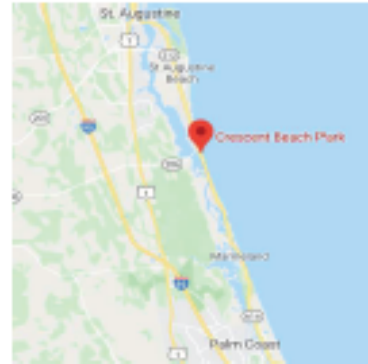


Fall District Ride-In 2020
